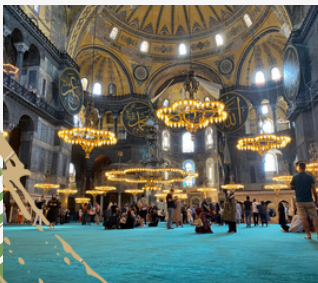
MEANINGFUL LEARNING THROUGH INTERDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION

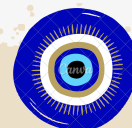




MERSIN
